



Team Manager Duties

As a Team Manager, you'll be one of the leaders of the Team on the sidelines, during Training Sessions & on Game days, for U5-U19. You will be assisting the Division Coaches & Players during the Pre-Game group Warm-Up's & Games. You are also encouraged to assist the Division Coaches, during Training sessions, if you choose to do so. Team managers lead the Team in communications such as Weather cancelations, Game details, & other various season updates. All Team Mangers will be linked to the TeamSnap App, where all details, updates, etc. will be shared. We then ask that you send out a group email or text to share this information with the Players families on your Squad/Team. Your duties do include communicating with your Team, on a regular basis, as you will be the point of contact for all SSA information, as well as schedule reminders, jersey color of the week, half-time snack schedules, etc.; you will assist our Coaches & Referees in assuring Players are ready to participate wearing Soccer Cleats, Shin Guards, Soccer Socks covering Shin Guards, No food gum, candy, etc. on the fields, & NO Jewelry. You're welcomed and encouraged to assign a Team Captain for each Game. (This usually coincides with the Player providing the after-game treat/snacks.)

All Team Managers must attend the Team Manager Mandatory Meeting, prior to the start of our season. Details regarding this meeting will be shared in a follow-up email.

***Please, Set a Good Example:**

The Team Manager should always reinforce a positive attitude on and off the field. The atmosphere you create will guide Players in a fun and engaging Soccer experience. Players are to be substituted regularly, rotated throughout all positions, and receive adequate water-breaks, when needed.

There are NO PETS of any kind on the Soccer Fields. NO ALCOHOL, or SMOKING/VAPING is permitted on the Soccer Fields. As a Team Manager you can remind others in violation of these rules. If you are uncomfortable addressing an individual with a Pet, consuming Alcohol, Smoking/Vaping, please reach out to one of our Field Supervisors for assistance.

We ask that you stand BEHIND the "Team Bench" with the Coach, or Sit with the Team & Coach during Games, utilizing your time on the sidelines to point out "Coachable-Moments" with the Players on the sidelines. Further details will be shared at our Team Managers & Coaches mandatory meeting. Shouting at the Players on the Field & Pacing the Sidelines are NOT acceptable. You are the Team Leader in Positive Reinforcement & Fair Play!
